BHS Safety Rules

April 20, 2019

Stay off the Belts

- Use caution; belts may start moving without warning
- Load conveyor belts only when belts are moving
- Do not sit, stand or walk on belts (authorized exceptions: Vanderlande [VI] personnel when belts are safely locked out/tagged out)

Conveyor Belts to be Re-Set Only by VI Personnel

- Do not pull jammed bags off belts; a strap or lock caught on a belt could cause major damage if not removed properly, potentially resulting in flight delays
- Call the VI Control Room at 310-215-1218 whenever there is a concern regarding the BHS belts
- Never attempt to re-start the BHS as it could result in injury

Bag Room Safety Rules

- Do not stand or park at building entrance or exit
- When operating a vehicle or tug always proceed with caution
- Close all container curtains before moving
- Do not transport baggage or cargo on top of carts or containers

Drive Safely in Baggage Areas

- Maximum allowable speed is 5 mph
- Vehicles should idle no more than 15 seconds to protect indoor air quality
- Keep arms and legs inside all moving vehicles
- Drive on right side of all lanes
- Tow no more than one (1) LD-7 or two (2) LD-8 dollies
- Tow no more than four (4) LD-3 dollies or four (4) bulk carts
- Containers are not to be stored in the TBITEC Bag Room; they may only be staged at the assigned sort pier four (4) hours prior to a flight's departure
- All dollies and bag carts are to be parked on their respective side of the white centerline between sort piers
